### SO WHAT'S THE BIG DEAL WITH LEPTOSPIROSIS ANYWAYS?

### Q: What is leptospirosis?

A: Leptospirosis, AKA "Lepto", is a bacteria that is passed through animal urine. It is shed into the environment where it can live for weeks to months. Commonly deer, squirrel, opossums and other wild animals transmit this bacteria.

### Q: Why should my pet get vaccinated for it?

A: Your pet can be infected with the bacteria and not show obvious signs, but when they do show clinical signs it is often hard to diagnose that leptospirosis caused the signs and treatment can be challenging as well. It can lead to kidney and liver disease. More importantly, you can catch it. Leptospirosis is zoonotic, meaning it can be transmitted to you if you come in contact with it by drinking contaminated water or even through a scratch on your skin.

### Q: What about all of the stories I hear saying my pet shouldn't get vaccinated for it due to vaccine reactions?

A: Any pet can have a reaction to a vaccine, just like any vaccine can cause a reaction. If your pet is sensitive to vaccinations we can discuss ways to decrease reactions, while keeping your pet protected. The leptospirosis vaccine is administered on a yearly basis.
