PUPPY CARE PROGRAM

The first six months of your puppy's life can be very enjoyable provided he or she stays happy and healthy. Your puppy can be subjected to a number of problems during this critical phase, most of which can be prevented. This program will cover exam/office call charges, as well as vaccines and treatments listed below during this six month period. This program does not cover extras such as: surgery, x-rays, medications and after hour calls.

8 weeks Comprehensive physical exam & 1st DHLPP (distemper hepatitis, leptospirosis,

parainfluenza and parvo-virus). Deworm for intestinal parasites.

Recommendations on heartworm prevention, including complimentary first dose of Heartgard. Puppy behavior problems, flea and tick prevention and diet

recommendations will also be discussed. Your puppy will also receive a

complete health record and weight check.

Brief exam, 2nd DHLPP, weight check and fecal exam. Please bring a fresh stool 12 weeks

sample. Continue heartworm preventative.

Brief exam, 3rd DHLPP, rabies vaccine and weight check. Recommendations on 16 weeks

spaying or neutering and basic puppy health care.
