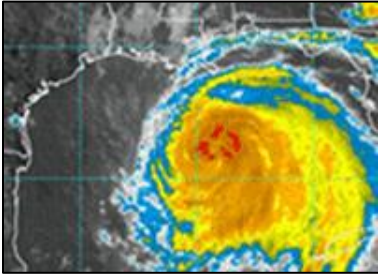

- Enough food and water for five days. Don't forget food and water bowls.
- Medications, vaccination records, and pet first aid kit.
- Comfort items, such as toys or blankets.
- Leash, harness, and carrier.
- Up to date tags and ids.

Please keep in mind that Pace Veterinary Clinic is rated to withstand a hurricane up to a level four. We do allow boarding during these seasons, but please understand we have limited space. If a hurricane is present, and you plan to evacuate don't hesitate to make your reservation.
