Did you know that 4.7 million Americans are bitten by dogs each year? Of that 4.7 million, more than half are children, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. "Children between the ages of five and nine years old, engaged in everyday activities with their own or a neighbor's dog, are the most frequent victims of dog bites," said The American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) President Dr. René Carlson. As a responsible dog owner, one of the best ways to protect our children and others from dog bites is to properly train and socialize our dogs.

The following tips are offered by The American Humane Society and The AVMA:

How to Avoid Being Bitten

- Don't leave a baby or small child alone with a dog, especially an unfamiliar dog.
- Don't run past a dog. The dog's natural instinct is to chase and catch you.
- Don't approach a strange dog, especially one that's tethered.

- Don't bother a dog that is sleeping, eating, or caring for puppies.
- Always obtain permission from the owner first, and let a dog see & sniff you before petting a dog
- Never tease a dog.

What to do if You Think a Dog May Attack

- Resist the impulse to scream and run away.
- Remain motionless, hands at your sides, and avoid eye contact with the dog.
- Once the dog loses interest in you, slowly back away until he is out of sight. If the dog does attack, place

- something between you and the dog such as a backpack, purse, bicycle, or jacket.
- If you are knocked down by a dog, curl up in a ball with your hands over your ears & face and remain motionless. Try not to scream or roll around.

What to do if You Have Been Bitten by a Dog

- If the dog owner is present, request proof of rabies vaccination, and get owner's name and contact information.
- Wash wound with warm water and soap as soon as possible.
- Consult your doctor immediately, or go to the emergency room if it is after hours.

Report the bite to your local animal care and control agency. Tell them everything you know about the dog and owner & and where he lives. If it is a stray, tell them what he looks like, where you saw him, whether you've seen him before, and which direction he went. The agency will contact the dog's veterinarian to check vaccination records.
