

What you can expect from our services:

Vaccinations

Our P.A.W. Plans are designed to offer your pet all the benefits of veterinary services available to him or her for one year. Included in this service for canines is an annual wellness examination and vaccinations including rabies, distemper, parvovirus, bordetella, and leptospirosis and for felines an annual



wellness examination and vaccinations including rabies, panleukopenia rhinotracheitis, and calicivirus.

Examination and consultation

A consultation with a veterinarian and a complete medical assessment begins with a thorough physical examination whereby your pet's eyes, ears, skin, cardiovascular, neurological, gastrointestinal and skeletal system are examined for any abnormalities.

Fecal testing for parasites

Often there are no symptoms that your pet might have a parasite, especially in the early stages. The microscopic examination of a stool sample will help us to determine the presence of intestinal parasites. We are looking for such things as roundworms, hookworms, whipworms, tapeworms, giardia and coccidia.

We recommend this test for all dogs and cats at least yearly for their health and also for yours as they can pass parasites to you and your family.

What you can expect from our services: <u>Pre Surgical Bloodwork</u>

It is recommended that your pet has blood testing before surgery. Even apparently healthy animals can have serious organ system problems that cannot be detected without blood testing. If there is a problem, it is much better to find it before it causes anesthetic or surgical complications. Typical tests identify hidden infections, anemia, potential bleeding problems, or immune suppression and also check how organs are functioning. This way we avoid stumbling into situations where inadequate organ function impairs anesthetic elimination or increases the likelihood of complications.



Lyme Disease and Heartworm TESTING



A blood test can be done to check for both Lyme disease and Heartworm. Lyme disease is transmitted to dogs through the bite of a tick. There has been an increase in the number of cases of Lyme disease in our area over recent years. Heartworm is a parasite that is transmitted by mosquitoes. It is recommended to test for both at least once a year when in for the annual exam.

Nail Trimming

Long nails can make walking uncomfortable and can even cause lameness. This is why trimming nails is important on a regular basis. As a rule they should be just off the ground when your pet is standing.



Spaying refers to the surgical procedure performed on female dogs and cats to render them infertile. There are many benefits to spaying your female companion. First, you will contribute to the prevention of the dog and cat overpopulation. Second, spaying will eliminate the sometimes 'messy' heat cycles that attract male dogs and cats to your house from miles away. Third, you will help prevent diseases in your pet such as pyometra (infection in the uterus) and mammary cancer. Spaying involves surgical removal of both ovaries and the uterus.

Neutering refers to the surgical procedure performed on male dogs and cats to render them infertile.

There are many benefits to neutering your male companion. First, you will contribute to the prevention of the dog and cat overpopulation. Second, neutering will eliminate undesirable and at times, embarrassing behavior in your male companion. Third, you will help prevent diseases in your pet such as prostate disease and testicular cancer. Neutering involves surgical removal of both testicles.
