What you can expect from our services:

### **Vaccinations**

Our P.A.W. Plans are designed to offer your new pet all the benefits of veterinary services available to him or her for one year. Included in this service for canines is an annual wellness examination and vaccinations including rabies, distemper, parvovirus, bordetella, and leptospirosis and for felines an annual wellness examination and vaccinations including



rabies, panleukopenia (distemper), leukemia, rhinotracheitis, and calicivirus.

### **Examination and consultation**

A consultation with a veterinarian and a complete medical assessment begins with a thorough physical examination whereby your pet's eyes, ears, skin, cardiovascular, neurological, gastrointestinal and skeletal system are examined for any abnormalities.

### **Fecal testing for parasites**

Often there are no symptoms that your pet might have a parasite, especially in the early stages. The microscopic examination of a stool sample will help us to determine the presence of intestinal parasites. We are looking for such things as roundworms, hookworms, whipworms, tapeworms, giardia and coccidia.

We recommend this test for all dogs and cats at least yearly for their health and also for yours as they can pass parasites to you and your family.

What you can expect from our services:

### Early Disease Detection with Blood work

Detection of disease at an early stage gives your pet a much better chance for a favorable response.

Combined with a physical examination, blood work can help discover health problems early.

#### Blood Chemistry Panel

With just one blood sample we can look inside the internal health of your pet! We can screen such organs as; the liver, kidney, pancreas, muscle and bone to detect disease such as pancreatitis, kidney failure, diabetes, seizures and some forms of cancer.

#### Blood Cell Count

It is important to know the levels of red blood cells and white blood cells. White blood cells help fight infection. White blood cell numbers can decrease with severe infection or with bone marrow disorders. White blood cells can also increase in response to inflammation and infection. Measuring Red blood cells can indicate autoimmune disease, genetic disorders, red cell infections, anemia or certain toxins. Platelets help with blood clotting. The platelet count may be decreased due to autoimmune disease, some types of cancer, infections spread by ticks or bone marrow disorders.

#### Thyroid Level Check

When checking thyroid levels in cats we are looking for above normal levels ( hyperthyroidism — hyperactivity, weight loss ) and in dogs we are looking for below normal levels ( hypothyroidism — sluggishness, weight gain, hair loss ). This is a screening test. If the result is abnormal, more detailed thyroid testing may be necessary to verify the diagnosis.



## **Nail Trimming**

Long nails can make walking uncomfortable and can even cause lameness. This is why trimming nails is important on a regular basis. As a rule they should be just off the ground when your pet is standing.



## **Urinalysis**

Urinalysis is a very important test for evaluating kidney function. Urinalysis is also a key test for determining if there is inflammation or infection in the urinary tract (bladder or kidneys). Urinalysis also helps to confirm, along with blood tests, whether or not an animal has a condition and needs further treatment.

## **Boarding**

We now offer short term cat boarding to our feline P.A.W. Plan holders. Our facility can accommodate many feline needs including administering medication and close monitoring for those pets with specific health issues.
