# Boarding/Daycare Drop-off Checklist

Before dropping your pet(s) off at Jensen Beach Animal Hospital please be sure to have the following:

### **FOOD**

To ensure consistency in your pet's diet we request that pet owners bring their pet's food when their dog or cat boards with us. A consistent diet helps minimize upset tummies and promotes a sense of familiarity. If at all possible, please bring your pet's food pre-measured per meal in zip lock baggies labeled with your pet's first and last name. By providing pre-measured food we can assure you that your pet will receive the same amount he/she receives at home and this allows our staff to monitor food intake.

## **MEDICATIONS**

All medication should be clearly labeled with your pet's name and dosage requirements. Feel free to include information on how best to administer your pet's medication. Knowing the best manner to provide your pet with their required medication will ensure that your pet receives their medication properly.

#### BEDDING

At JBAH we want your pet to feel comfy and cozy when they settle in for the night. Personal bedding from home is always welcome. We have found that blankets and fleece snuggles work best as they can be washed easily and are not as susceptible to destruction. This is particularly important for our doggy guests. Foam beds and big bean-bag-like beds are difficult for us to properly wash and dry. For kitties, feel free to bring their round foam beds or blankets.

#### **TOYS**

Please limit the number of toys to 2 to 3 pieces. This does not include bedding and medication. Since some of our canine guests take advantage of down time by chewing enthusiastically, bring one good chew toy and keep the "most treasured toy" at home. Bring new toys or chew bones that will stimulate your pet's interest and make their stay more enjoyable. Toys smaller than a tennis ball cannot be accepted for dogs. Our staff will take every precaution to ensure all belongings are returned to you, but we cannot be responsible for lost or destroyed items.

## **VACCINATIONS**

Your pet(s)vaccination records MUST be up-todate before we are able to accept them for boarding or daycare.

#### **Required dog vaccines:**

Rabies, Bordetella, and Distemper.

#### **Required cat vaccines:**

Rabies and Distemper. Feline leukemia vaccine is recommended but not required.

- \*\*Please be sure to label all belongings with pet name and last name to ensure we do not accidentally mix it in with kennel supplies.
- \*\* All boarders will be checked for fleas/ticks.

  If necessary, treatment will be provided at owner's expense.
