## CANINE VACCINE PROTOCOL

DA2PV- Puppies

(8 weeks of age) 1<sup>st</sup> of 3, injectable vaccine. (12 weeks of age) 2<sup>nd</sup> of 3, injectable vaccine. (16 weeks of age) 3<sup>rd</sup> of 3, injectable vaccine (annual vaccine).

\*\*\*BOOSTERS GIVEN 3-4 WEEKS APART\*\*\*

If over 12 weeks of age with no previous vaccines, a series of 2 DA2PV vaccines will be given, 3-4 weeks apart. The second vaccine will be an annual. At the next annual the DA2PV vaccine given will then be given every 3 years.

**LEPTOSPIROSIS-** 9 weeks of age and up. The second booster vaccine is given 3-4 weeks later, then annually.

LYME- 8 weeks and up. The second booster vaccine is given 3-4 weeks later, then annually.

**RABIES-** 12 weeks of age and up. The very first rabies vaccine given is a 1 year vaccine, if there is proof of a previous vaccine then it will be a 3 year vaccine, unless they are under 12 months of age, then it will

be a 1 year vaccine.

**4DX TESTING-** 10-12 months of age and up, annual testing recommended; if from a high risk area or not started on heartworm preventative at approximately 8 weeks of age. Testing may be recommended sooner.

Heartworm prevention medication should start at 8 weeks of age either with Revolution, Interceptor or Heartgard.

BORDETELLA/PARAINFLUENZA VACCINE AS NEEDED.

SPAY/NEUTERING- 12 weeks of age and up.
