FELINE VACCINE PROTOCOL

FVRCP (distemper)- Kittens

(8 weeks of age) 1st of 3, intra nasal vaccine.
(12 weeks of age) 2nd of 3, injectable vaccine.
(16 weeks of age) 3rd of 3, injectable vaccine (annual vaccine).
At the next annual visit the FVRCP vaccine given will then be given every 3 years

*** BOOSTERS GIVEN 3-4 WEEKS APART***

If over 12 weeks of age with no previous vaccines, a series of 2 FVRCP vaccines will be given, 3-4 weeks apart. The second vaccine will be an annual. At the next annual visit the FVRCP vaccine given will then be given every 3 years.

FELV (leukemia)- 9 weeks of age and up. If not previously vaccinated, a series of 2 FELV vaccines will be given,

3-4 weeks apart. Then vaccinated every 2 years.

PUREVAX RABIES- Given at 12 weeks of age and up, then annually.

FELV/FIV/HW TESTING- Every new patient with an unknown history ie: stray, adoption.

WAIT FOR RESULTS PRIOR TO VACCINATING

SPAY/NEUTERING- 12 weeks of age and up.
