Petersen Pet Hospital broke ground on a new building at 1031 Kacena Road in Hiawatha, Iowa in September. The new building will be approximately 9580 sq. ft.



The new location was designed to better serve our clients and patients with additional exam rooms, a large comfort room, a special dental suite, surgery suite, intensive care unit, isolation ward, luxury dog and cat boarding, and additional parking.

Luxury dog boarding will be new to this facility. The suites will have views of the pond and the woods located to the east of the building and each suite will be private and decorated with a theme. We currently have cat condos, but the new facility will offer the cats a beautiful view of the pond and the wildlife in the area while they stay with us.

"To enable us to provide the best care for our patients, it was important to us to expand the size of our hospital to include such things as an intensive care unit for improved monitoring of our patients, an isolation ward to keep contagious patients separate from other patients, and a comfort room to provide our clients with a quiet area for pet euthanasia to name a few," says Dr. Brad Petersen.

Did you know that Petersen Pet Hospital offers ultrasound for your companion?



Ultrasound can allow us to visualize the internal organs of your pet with no known side effects. This tool can be useful for finding abnormalities of the heart, liver, stomach, bladder, kidneys and other organs.

Ultrasound can help us detect diseases early and is a pain free test.

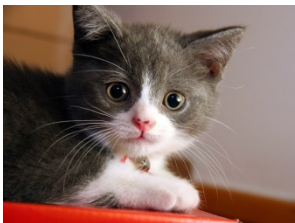


Some reasons we may recommend an ultrasound be performed on your pet could be:

- weight loss even though your pet is having no changes in eating habit
- cancer staging
- if abnormal values are seen on bloodwork
- diarrhea or vomiting that has lasted a long time
- baseline for our senior pets
- change in urinary habits
- heart murmur found
- pregnancy check
- fluid in belly or chest

Is this safe?

While it is hard to resist the temptation of sparkling lights and glittering tinsel, these items can be very hazardous to pets. If your pet ingests tinsel, it can become lodged in the intestinal tract and cause a linear foreign body to develop. Correction for this includes costly surgery and, in severe cases, serious complications can arise. Many animals enjoy chewing on electrical cords from tree lights, or biting the lights themselves.

This can result in electrical burns to the mouth and tongue and other complications from electrocution. Your homemade ornaments can also pose a risk. Homemade ornament dough is high in salt, which may cause electrolyte abnormalities and seizures. Hang these decorations high on the tree or pets may think they're meant for them!
