# New Hospital Coming Summer 2018

The electrical and plumbing is nearing completion and the central vacuum system has been installed. We added that feature in our new hospital to keep our facility as clean as possible. They are currently installing flooring and will start the parking lot mid-late April.

When this scenario arises, we ask the client to either reschedule the appointment (if not an emergency or sick appointment) for a later time and/or date or wait for the next available opening that day. For all appointments going forward, we ask that you arrive 5 minutes early for your appointment and if running late, to contact us promptly in case we need to reschedule that appointment.

# New Service Coming to Petersen Pet Hospital

#### **Luxury Dog Boarding**



Once we get moved into our new hospital, we will be providing Luxury Dog Boarding. Our goal is to provide your dog(s) a relaxing, safe, and secure stay when in our care. To accomplish this, we will provide:



- 6 30 square foot dog runs with a window overseeing a wooded area and pond
- Every dog will be leashed walked 2-3 times daily outside within a fenced area
- Continuous overhead music in the boarding area
- Tempered glass dog run doors instead of bars (bars create stress for dogs)



- Whole hospital sprinkler system in case of a fire
- Security cameras so staff can check in on boarders after hours



- Raised dog beds
- Boarding area is cleaned and disinfected daily

# **Cat Boarding – Important Information**

When your cat stays with us for boarding, their health and safety is of utmost importance to us. Because of this, we have modified our requirements for a cat to be able to board with us.

#### The requirements are:

- Examined by a Petersen Pet Hospital veterinarian within the last year.
- Current on Rabies and FVRCP (distemper) vaccinations.
- A negative intestinal parasite test within the last year. (If positive, patient will be treated at owner's expense.)

 Documentation that a Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV)/Feline Immunodeficiency Virus(FIV) test has been completed in their lifetime.

If any of the above items have been performed at another veterinary hospital, please bring documentation at time of check-in.
