TTA-2 Procedure Now Available

We now offer the TTA-2 (Tibial Tuberosity Advancement 2) procedure for the correction of cruciate ligament tears in dogs. A torn cranial cruciate ligament is the most common athletic injury in dogs, often referred to as an "ACL" tear. This advanced technique allows the dog to heal faster and provides a quicker return to normal activity than compared to other surgical techniques.







Flea Season

During the months of August throughout October we see our highest number of flea infestation cases. Fleas can be a problem year-round but these months are worse due to the fact that fleas have had all summer long to gain their numbers among our pets as well as wildlife. Be sure your pets are protected against fleas by using a flea preventative product that we recommend. Oral Nexgard and Bravecto are best for dogs and topical
